At the Organizational Meeting of the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York held January 9, 2020, the following was approved:

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE TOWN OF PLATTSBURGH

WHEREAS, the City of Plattsburgh owns and maintains approximately 2 miles of trail at the former Plattsburgh Airforce Base known as the Terry Gordon bike path; and

WHEREAS, the Terry Gordon bike path is scheduled for upgrades in 2020 which coincides with the Town of Plattsburgh's plans to develop the Battlefields Memorial Gateway (BMG), located at the terminus of the Terry Gordon bike path; and

WHEREAS, The BMG plan includes a multi-use path which will connect to the Terry Gordon bike path and will provide an opportunity for further extension of the Empire State Trail and offer additional amenities along an already picturesque path.

NOW THEREFORE, the City of Plattsburgh Common Council duly convened does hereby:

RESOLVE, that the City of Plattsburgh enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Town of Plattsburgh to collaborate and provide recreational and cultural benefits to City & Town residents along with multitudes of visitors; and further be it


RESOLVED, that the Common Council authorizes the Mayor to sign the Memorandum of Understanding.
